| Maths | Literacy | Other Activity Ideas |
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| <p><u>Counting in 2s</u></p> <p>You can refer to previous learning when carrying out these activities and reinforce that these numbers are all even.</p> <p>Use the 100 square sent home in the pack. Use a counter to make jumps of 2 and say the numbers as they land on them.</p> <p>Make number cards/stones 2, 4, 6, 8, 10 to 20/30 as you feel is appropriate for your child. Mix the numbers up and get your child to order them.</p> <p>Orally count in 2s forwards and backwards.</p> <p>Use 2p's - make a mini shop, price everything 2p. Take turns to buy items and count up in 2s to add up the total.</p> <p>Use socks/shoes to practically count in 2s - you could get your children to pair up the socks in the washing.</p> <p>Adding 2 calculations - use objects (practical) or the 100 square (to count on) to support. Your child can create and write addition calculations in their maths books (stick to even numbers) eg $4+2=$, $12+2=$</p> | <p>Use the following link and read/listen to the book https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=kUEw7ZReZL8</p> <p>Use books/internet to find out about jungle animals. Choose one and create an 'animal fact-file'. This could be done using bullet points. Encourage the children to use their phonic knowledge to sound out some of the words.</p> <p>Think of words that rhyme with snake, draw pictures and write words.</p> <p>Use the Polysyllabic powerpoint attached to the email, children use their phonic knowledge to read the words and draw a picture to depict what it is.</p> <p>Sing along to this Walking through the Jungle song https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=2o332s5HI0c</p> <p>Use the letters in your reading folder to make words that have the 'igh' and 'air' sound in them. Make a word then write it down.</p> <p>Read the Rising Stars Book - Parrot Problem - Comet Street Kids - band 3</p> | <p>Watch these episodes of The Go Jetters visiting The Amazon and The Sumatra https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episode/b07ff060/go-jettters-series-1-19-amazon-rainforest-south-america https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episode/b095tf9l/sign/go-jettters-series-2-4-rainforests-of-sumatra-indonesia</p> <p>Use this link to look at and explore more in depth detail about rainforests (actually a year 8 lesson but the short video of the rainforest is really interesting and I know we have some very inquisitive children who always want to know more). https://www.bbc.co.uk/bitesize/articles/zkbmt39</p> <p>Create a 'jungle' scene, this could be 2D or 3D. You could use natural materials (good one for using your garden) or you could draw, paint, collage using mediums of your choice.</p> <p>Make a rainmaker using a tube. Fill with one of the following - rice, pasta, dried beans/peas. Then decorate.</p> <p>Have fun moving like the animals in the book. Play - guess the animal, take it in turns to move like an animal and see if someone else can guess what you're trying to be.</p> <p>Use the following link to listen to a wide range of sounds from the Jungle and encourage your child to think about,</p> |
