

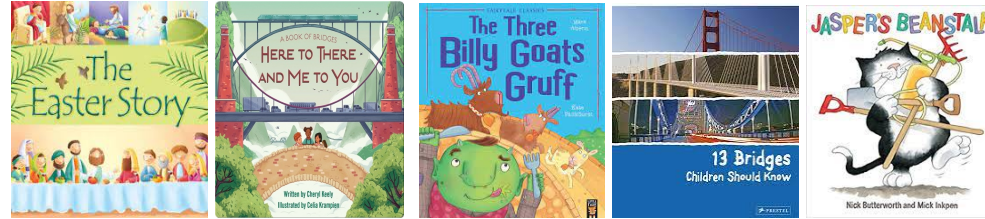

Begin to learn the Days of the Week. Explore with and begin to name a range of 3D shapes. Explore breadth and distance using non-standard measures.</p>	<p>Retell and recreate the Mlni Adventure key stories by using story props and creating my own story props. Use these as a springboard to develop my own simple stories and narratives. Begin to understand 'why' and 'how' questions. Question why things happen and give simple explanations. Extend vocabulary by grouping and naming Use a clear speaking voice when communicating to others. Describe what I see, think and feel. Use language related to size.</p>	<p>Show some awareness of rhyme and alliteration and enjoy taking part in rhyming and rhythmic activities. Join in with familiar rhymes and poems Anticipates key events and phrases in rhymes, poems &amp; stories. Show an interest in print and illustrations in books and print in the environment Give meaning to the mark I make as they draw, write and paint. Sequence pictures to show knowledge and understanding of the story The Three Billy Goats Gruff.</p>	<p>Create daffodil observational drawings, paintings and creations using a variety of medium and materials. Explore different ways of attaching materials together. Explore pushing and pulling. Design and create a bridge to help the goats across the river. Create a troll using naturally found and man-made materials. Create own natural paint brushes using naturally found materials using simple knot tying skills Listen to and appraise a range of 'Spring' music - explore how this makes me feel through movement and art.</p>
