

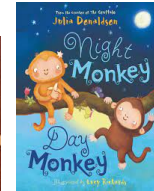

<p>Know the following rhymes by heart - Five Currant Buns &amp; Five Little Gingerbread Men</p> <p>Explore the concept of time using the story Night Monkey, day Monkey</p> <p>Use some number names and number language spontaneously during play</p> <p>Recognise some numerals of personal significance</p> <p>Recite numbers in sequence</p> <p>Know that numbers identify how many objects there are in a set</p>	<p>Begin to join in with repeated refrains and anticipate key events and phrases in the story</p> <p>Recount the story in my own words and create my own versions of the story using small world, story props</p> <p>Retell and recreate the story through role play and the use of puppets</p> <p>Describe the materials and objects I am exploring using a variety of simple adjectives</p> <p>Use adjectives to describe story characters</p>	<p>Play I spy and Kim's game to develop early phonetic awareness</p> <p>Show some awareness of how stories are structured and begin to understand that a story has a beginning and an end</p> <p>Sequence the story The Gingerbread Man using pictures</p> <p>Name and label the parts of The Gingerbread Man</p> <p>Create own versions of the story using small world and story props</p>	<p>Use a variety of tools to effect changes to mediums and materials</p> <p>Create simple Mandala and Rangoli patterns</p> <p>Create a fireworks picture using a paint</p> <p>Create a Gingerbread man</p> <p>Create a trap to catch the gingerbread man</p> <p>Watch a musical re-telling of The Gingerbread Man featuring musicians from the BBC Philharmonic orchestra and talk about and explore the instruments used</p>

<p>Think about how the story characters would have been feeling at different points in the story and make links to times when I have had those feelings</p> <p>Talk about what the characters of the story are good at and recognise and celebrate my achievements and be proud of them</p> <p>Demonstrate that I can make independent choices</p> <p>Talk about why food is important to me and know that not everyone has the food they need</p> <p>Respect the feelings and views of others</p>	<p>Use the internet, books and resources to find out about why we celebrate Bonfire night</p> <p>Explore and sort a variety of materials</p> <p>Explore what happens when we heat, cool and cook with a variety of ingredients - gingerbread men, jelly and chocolate</p> <p>Create a map of the Gingerbread Man's journey from the oven to the river</p> <p>Explore the Hindu festival of Diwali - The Festival of Lights through the story of Rama and Sita</p> <p>Explore why we have Remembrance Day</p>	<p>Move in different directions, using a variety of pathways and levels</p> <p>Demonstrate increasing awareness of the space around them</p> <p>Use large physical equipment with increasing confidence showing an awareness of safety for themselves and others</p> <p>Use scissors to cut a variety of shapes and lines and then apply these to create a gingerbread man</p> <p>Use mark making tools to represent The Gingerbread Man</p>	<p>Explore the following Bible stories and Christian Values using Jack in the Box as inspiration:</p> <p>Noah's Ark - Trust &amp; Promises</p> <p>Moses - Compassion &amp; Hope</p> <p>Jonah and the Whale - Courage</p> <p>Daniel and the Lions - Joy</p>
