



Use of Pupil Premium Funding 2016-7

The Government allocates extra money to schools in the form of Pupil Premium Funding to raise the attainment of children in receipt of Free School Meals (FSM) and to close the gap in attainment between FSM students and non FSM pupils.

Due to the current numbers of students eligible for pupil premium funding we have been allocated the following amount for the financial Year 2016 -17:

In line with our School Development Plan to raise attainment for all pupils; we have allocated the following funding for April 2016-7 to the following areas:

1. Additional hours for TA support

Funding has allowed us to maintain our relatively high levels of teaching assistant support in school, allowing small grp support for children in class rooms and also in activities such as our communication group

2. Support for curriculum enrichment activities

As we believe that developing the whole child is key to them achieving their potential we ensure that all children have the opportunity to attend a residential in years 3 and 4 and are given the opportunity to take part in after school clubs as appropriate
